

# VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Apex Companies, LLC, (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reported by Interface, Inc. (Interface) for the period stated below. This verification statement applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions is the sole responsibility of Interface. Interface is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions statement in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions reported, and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG statement based on the verification.

## Period covered by GHG emissions verification:

• January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020

### Criteria against which verification was conducted:

• World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2)

### **Reference Standard:**

 ISO 14064-3: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the validation and verification of greenhouse gas statements

### Level of Assurance and Qualifications:

- Reasonable (Scope 1 and 2).
- This verification used a materiality threshold of ±5% for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.

### **GHG Verification Methodology:**

Evidence-gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Interface;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by Interface;
- Review of Interface data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis and review of information used to determine GHG emissions; and
- Audit of sample of data used by Interface to determine GHG emissions.

## Verification Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, we conclude that the Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions statement shown above:

- is materially correct and is a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- is prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2).

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the Scope 3 GHG emissions statement shown above:

- is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3)

It is our opinion that Interface has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data for determination of these GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.
